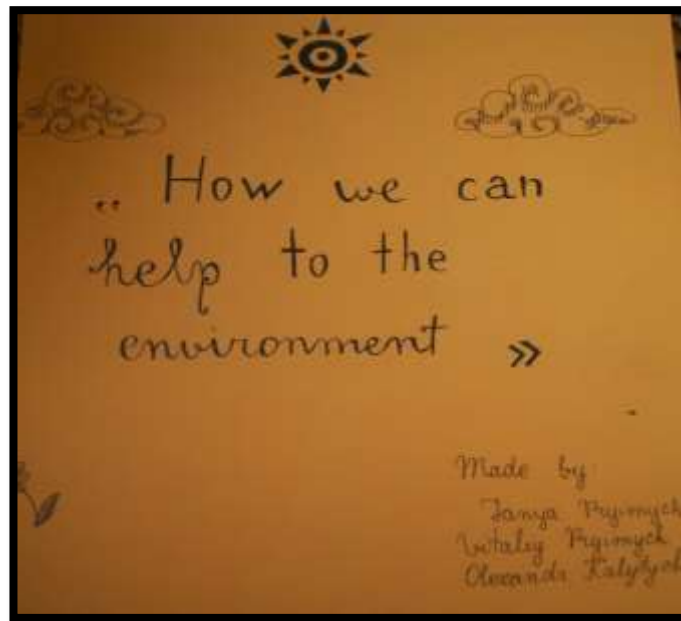
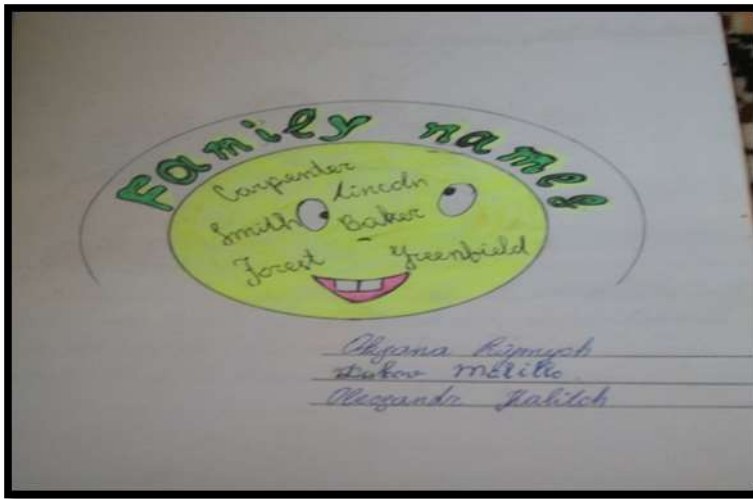






Many, many years ago lived old woman. She had only one son and she loved him more than all in the world. She called him "Ndikidigha". From this word it became his family name.

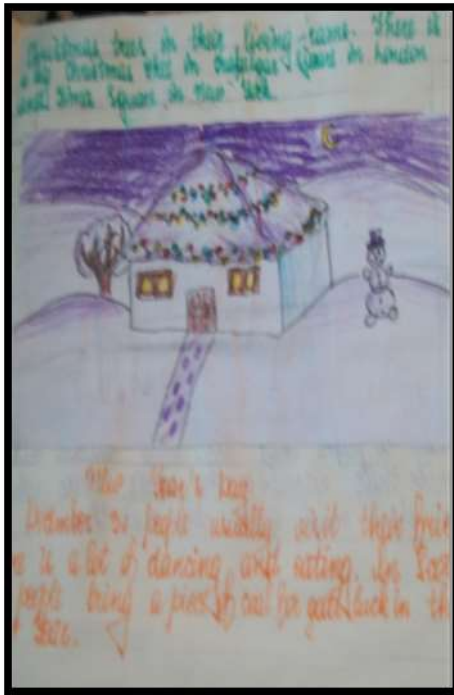
